

Environmental Policy

It is the policy of Compressed Air Solutions Ltd to carry out its day-to-day operations in such a manner as to balance the requirements of operating efficiency with concern to minimise the impact of the business upon the environment. This Policy should be read in conjunction with the Carbons Emissions Reduction Policy.

Compressed Air Solutions Ltd will look to establish processes and procedures to ensure continual improvement in environmental performance and pollution prevention by way of:

- Complying with all relevant environmental legislation and regulations relevant to the day-to-day operations of the business.
- Complying with other environmental requirements as set by industry codes of practise, contractual requirements, voluntary agreements or restrictions.
- Sourcing and promoting a product range to minimise the environmental impact of key suppliers' production and distribution.
- Minimising non-hazardous waste produced by day-to-day operations of the business by working with other businesses to reuse and recycle packaging and other reusable materials.
- Ensuring all potentially hazardous substances stored on the premises are kept in a manner as to minimise the possibility of escape to the environment.
- Minimising hazardous waste produced by day-to-day operations by maintaining customers compressed air equipment in accordance with manufacturers guidelines.
- Monitoring the amount and content of additional non-hazardous waste disposed of by way of waste reports from waste disposal contractors.
- Minimising the toxic emissions from all vehicles by maintaining them in accordance with manufacturer's guidelines and car sharing where possible.
- Actively reducing energy consumption by implementing a 'switch off' policy for any equipment not in use and by providing all office staff with LCD screens.
- Undertaking annual management meetings to review the environmental performance of the business.
- Monitoring scope 1 and scope 2 emissions and utility consumption.
